Genesis 1:3 AMP

And **God said**, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Genesis 1:6 AMP

And **God said**, "Let there be an expanse [of the sky] in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters [below the expanse] from the waters [above the expanse]."

Genesis 1:9 AMP

Then **God said**, "Let the waters below the heavens be gathered into one place [of standing, pooling together], and let the dry land appear"; and it was so.

Genesis 1:11 AMP

So **God said**, "Let the earth sprout [tender] vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit according to (limited to, consistent with) their kind, whose seed is in them upon the earth"; and it was so.

Genesis 1:14 AMP

Then **God said**, "Let there be light-bearers (sun, moon, stars) in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be useful for signs (tokens) [of God's provident care], and for marking seasons, days, and years;

Genesis 1:20 AMP

Then **God said**, "Let the waters swarm and abundantly produce living creatures, and let birds soar above the earth in the open expanse of the heavens."

Genesis 1:24 AMP

Then **God said**, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to (limited to, consistent with) their kind: livestock, crawling things, and wild animals of the earth according to their kinds"; and it was so [because He had spoken them into creation].

Genesis 1:26 AMP

Then **God said**, "Let Us (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) make man in Our image, according to Our likeness [not physical, but a spiritual personality and moral likeness]; and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the cattle, and over the entire earth, and over everything that creeps and crawls on the earth."

Genesis 1:28 ESV

And God blessed them. And **God said** to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the

earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Genesis 1:29 AMP

So **God said**, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the surface of the entire earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you;

Genesis 2:18 AMP

Now the LORD **God said**, "It is not good (beneficial) for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper [one who balances him—a counterpart who is] suitable and complementary for him."

Genesis 3:1 KJVS

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath **God said**, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

Genesis 3:3 AMP

except the fruit from the tree which is in the middle of the garden. **God said**, 'You shall not eat from it nor touch it, otherwise you will die.'"

Genesis 3:11 AMP

God said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten [fruit] from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?"

Genesis 3:13 AMP

Then the LORD **God said** to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" And the woman said, "The serpent beguiled and deceived me, and I ate [from the forbidden tree]."

Genesis 3:14 AMP

The LORD **God said** to the serpent, "Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all the cattle, And more than any animal of the field; On your belly you shall go, And dust you shall eat All the days of your life.

Genesis 3:16 TLB

Then **God said** to the woman, "You shall bear children in intense pain and suffering; yet even so, you shall welcome your husband's affections, and he shall be your master."

Genesis 3:17 AMP

Then to Adam the LORD **God said**, “Because you have listened [attentively] to the voice of your wife, and have eaten [fruit] from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, ‘You shall not eat of it’; The ground is [now] under a curse because of you; In sorrow and toil you shall eat [the fruit] of it All the days of your life.

Genesis 3:22 AMP

And the LORD **God said**, “Behold, the man has become like one of Us (Father, Son, Holy Spirit), knowing [how to distinguish between] good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take from the tree of life as well, and eat [its fruit], and live [in this fallen, sinful condition] forever”—

Genesis 6:13 AMP

God said to Noah, “I intend to make an end of all that lives, for through men the land is filled with violence; and behold, I am about to destroy them together with the land.

Genesis 8:15 ESV

Then **God said** to Noah,

Genesis 9:8 ESV

Then **God said** to Noah and to his sons with him,

Genesis 9:12 AMP

And **God said**, “This is the token (visible symbol, memorial) of the [solemn] covenant which I am making between Me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations;

Genesis 9:17 AMP

And **God said** to Noah, “This [rainbow] is the sign of the covenant (solemn pledge, binding agreement) which I have established between Me and all living things on the earth.”

Genesis 15:9 AMP

So **God said** to him, “Bring Me a three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old female goat, a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon.”

Genesis 15:13 AMP

God said to Abram, “Know for sure that your descendants will be strangers [living temporarily] in a land (Egypt) that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed for four hundred years.

Genesis 17:3 ESV

Then Abram fell on his face. And **God said** to him,

Genesis 17:9 AMP

Further, **God said** to Abraham, "As for you [your part of the agreement], you shall keep and faithfully obey [the terms of] My covenant, you and your descendants after you throughout their generations.

Genesis 17:15 AMP

Then **God said** to Abraham, "As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name Sarai (my princess), but her name will be Sarah (Princess).

Genesis 17:19 AMP

But **God said**, "No, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son indeed, and you shall name him Isaac (laughter); and I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant and with his descendants after him.

Genesis 18:13 TLB

Then **God said** to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh? Why did she say 'Can an old woman like me have a baby?'

Genesis 18:28 TLB

Suppose there are only forty-five? Will you destroy the city for lack of five?" And **God said**, "I will not destroy it if I find forty-five."

Genesis 18:31 TLB

Then Abraham said, "Since I have dared to speak to God, let me continue-suppose there are only twenty?" And **God said**, "Then I won't destroy it for the sake of the twenty."

Genesis 18:32 TLB

Finally, Abraham said, "Oh, let not the Lord be angry; I will speak but this once more! Suppose only ten are found?" And **God said**, "Then, for the sake of the ten, I won't destroy it."

Genesis 20:6 AMP

Then **God said** to him in the dream, "Yes, I know you did this in the integrity of your heart, for it was I who kept you back and spared you from sinning against Me; therefore I did not give you an opportunity to touch her.

Genesis 21:12 AMP

God said to Abraham, "Do not let it distress you because of Ishmael and your maid;

whatever Sarah tells you, listen to her and do what she asks, for your descendants will be named through Isaac.

Genesis 22:2 AMP

God said, "Take now your son, your only son [of promise], whom you love, Isaac, and go to the region of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

Genesis 31:11 AMP

And the Angel of **God said** to me in the dream, 'Jacob.' And I said, 'Here I am.'

Genesis 35:1 AMP

Then **God said** to Jacob, "Go up to Bethel and live there, and make an altar there to God, who appeared to you [in a distinct manifestation] when you fled [years ago] from Esau your brother."

Genesis 35:10 AMP

Again **God said** to him, "Your name is Jacob; You shall no longer be called Jacob, But Israel shall be your name." So he was called Israel.

Genesis 35:11 AMP

And **God said** to him, "I am God Almighty. Be fruitful and multiply; A nation and a company of nations shall come from you, And kings shall be born of your loins.

Genesis 46:3 HCSB

God said, "I am God, the God of your father. Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I will make you into a great nation there.

Exodus 3:5 AMP

Then **God said**, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet [out of respect], because the place on which you are standing is holy ground."

Exodus 3:12 AMP

And **God said**, "Certainly I will be with you, and this shall be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve and worship God at this mountain."

Exodus 3:14 AMP

God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "You shall say this to the Israelites, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

Exodus 3:15 KJVS

And **God said** moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

Exodus 4:7 AMP

Then **God said**, "Put your hand into your robe again." So he put his hand back into his robe, and when he took it out, it was restored [and was] like the rest of his body.

Exodus 4:8 ESV

"If they will not believe you," **God said**, "or listen to the first sign, they may believe the latter sign.

Exodus 13:17 AMP

So it happened, when Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, even though it was nearer; for **God said**, "The people might change their minds when they see war [that is, that there will be war], and return to Egypt."

Exodus 24:1 AMP

Then **God said** to Moses, "Come up to the LORD, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu (Aaron's older sons), and seventy of Israel's elders, and you shall worship at a [safe] distance.

Exodus 33:19 AMP

And **God said**, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the Name of the LORD before you; for I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show compassion (lovingkindness) on whom I will show compassion."

Exodus 34:10 AMP

Then **God said**, "Behold, I am going to make a covenant. Before all your people I will do wondrous works (miracles) such as have not been created or produced in all the earth nor among any of the nations; and all the people among whom you live shall see the working of the LORD, for it is a fearful and awesome thing that I am going to do with you.

Numbers 22:12 AMP

God said to Balaam, "Do not go with them; you shall not curse the people [of Israel], for they are blessed."

Deuteronomy 1:6 ESV

"The LORD our **God said** to us in Horeb, 'You have stayed long enough at this mountain.

Deuteronomy 10:9 ESV

Therefore Levi has no portion or inheritance with his brothers. The LORD is his inheritance, as the LORD your **God said** to him.)

Judges 6:20 AMP

The Angel of **God said** to him, "Take the meat and unleavened bread and lay them on this rock, and pour out the broth [over them]." And he did so.

1 Samuel 15:19 TLB

Then why didn't you obey the Lord? Why did you rush for the loot and do exactly what **God said** not to?"

1 Kings 3:5 AMP

In Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream at night; and **God said**, "Ask [Me] what I shall give you."

1 Kings 3:11 AMP

God said to him, "Because you have asked this and have not asked for yourself a long life nor for wealth, nor for the lives of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to recognize justice,

1 Kings 13:8 AMP

But the man of **God said** to the king, "Even if you were to give me half your house (wealth), I would not go with you, nor would I eat bread or drink water in this place.

2 Kings 4:27 AMP

When she came to the mountain to the man of God, she took hold of his feet. Gehazi approached to push her away; but the man of **God said**, "Let her alone, for her soul is desperate and troubled within her; and the LORD has hidden the reason from me and has not told me."

2 Kings 6:6 AMP

1 Chronicles 11:2 AMP

So David inquired again of God, and **God said** to him, "Do not go up after them; circle around behind them and come at them in front of the balsam trees.

1 Chronicles 17:3 TLB

But that same night **God said** to Nathan,

1 Chronicles 28:3 AMP

But **God said** to me, 'You shall not build a house for My Name (Presence), because you are a man of war and have shed blood.'

2 Chronicles 1:11 HCSB

God said to Solomon, "Since this was in your heart, and you have not requested riches, wealth, or glory, or for the life of those who hate you, and you have not even requested long life, but you have requested for yourself wisdom and knowledge that you may judge My people over whom I have made you king,

2 Chronicles 33:7 ESV

And the carved image of the idol that he had made he set in the house of God, of which **God said** to David and to Solomon his son, "In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, I will put my name forever,

2 Chronicles 35:21 YLT

and he sendeth unto him messengers, saying, 'What -- to me and to thee, O king of Judah? not against thee do I come to-day, but unto the house with which I have war, and **God said** to haste me; cease for thee from God who [is] with me, and He doth not destroy thee.'

Psalms 50:16 YLT

And to the wicked hath **God said**: What to thee -- to recount My statutes? That thou liftest up My covenant on thy mouth?

Isaiah 28:16 HCSB

Therefore the Lord **GOD said**: "Look, I have laid a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; the one who believes will be unshakable.

Isaiah 37:30 TLB

Then **God said** to Hezekiah, "Here is the proof that I am the one who is delivering this city from the king of Assyria: This year he will abandon his siege. Although it is too late now to plant your crops, and you will have only volunteer grain this fall, still it will give you enough seed for a small harvest next year, and two years from now you will be living in luxury again.

Jeremiah 25:15 TLB

For the Lord **God said** to me: "Take from my hand this wine cup filled to the brim with my fury, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink from it.

Jeremiah 26:18 TLB

"The decision is right; for back in the days when Micah of Moresheth prophesied in the days of King Hezekiah of Judah, he told the people that **God said**: 'This hill shall be plowed like an open field and this city of Jerusalem razed into heaps of stone, and a forest shall grow at the top where the great Temple now stands!'

Hosea 1:6 KJVS
