1. PRACTICING [AWE-inspiring Witness-within Evangelizing]: A LIVING LEGACY

DEVELOPING DAILY PERSONAL FAMILY PRAYING AND BIBLE STUDY:

1.1. BEING A CHRISTIAN: Acts 11:25-26 ESV So Barnabas went to Tarsus to look for Saul, [26] and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. For a whole year they met with the church and taught a great many people. And in Antioch the disciples were first called Christians. Gather together with your Family, or a couple friends once a week.

1.2. AIM: Make yourselves "ACCOUNTABLE" to each other. Study John 9:41 ESV Jesus said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no guilt; but now that you say, 'We see,' your guilt remains.

Romans 3:19 ESV Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.

Review 1 Corinthians 7:17 ESV Only let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him. This is my rule in all the churches.

1.3. Build "INTEGRITY" with Matthew 5:8 AMP "Blessed [anticipating God's presence, spiritually mature] are the pure in heart [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], for they will see God. Also, see Galatians 5:25 AMP If we [claim to] live by the [Holy] Spirit, we must also walk by the Spirit [with personal integrity, godly character, and moral courage—our conduct empowered by the Holy Spirit]. Remember 1 Corinthians 6:5 AMP I say this to your shame. Can it be that there is not one wise man among you who [is governed by integrity and] will be able and competent to decide [private disputes] between his fellow believers?

2. TIP: In Ezekiel 3:16-17 AMP says: Ezekiel 3:16 KJVS And it came to pass at the end of seven days, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, "Son of man, I have appointed you as a watchman to the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from My mouth, warn them from Me.

3. NEW THING: Matthew 13:51-52 ESV "Have you understood all these things?" They said to him, "Yes." [52] And he said to them, "Therefore every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like a master of a house, who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old."

1 Thessalonians 5:9-22 ESV For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, [10] who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him. [11] Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing. [12] We ask you, brothers, to respect those who labor among you and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, [13] and to esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves. [14] And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all. [15] See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. [16] Rejoice always, [17] pray without ceasing, [18] give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. [19] Do not quench the Spirit. [20] Do not despise prophecies, [21] but test everything; hold fast what is good. [22] Abstain from every form of evil.

Acts 1:7-8 ESV He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. [8] But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

EVANGELIZING: Everyone seeks love, significance, and security. If you don't have these in your life, you experience a void in your life. Mark 7:12-13 ESV then you no longer permit him to do anything for his father or mother, [13] thus making void the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And many such things you do."

Luke 16:17 ESV But it is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for one dot of the Law to become void.

Acts 24:16 KJV And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men.

Romans 10:19 ESV But I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation; with a foolish nation I will make you angry."

2 Timothy 1:8-12 ESV Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, nor of me his prisoner, but share in suffering for the gospel by the power of God, [9] who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of his own purpose and grace, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began, [10] and which now has been manifested through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, [11] for which I was appointed a preacher and apostle and teacher, [12] which is why I suffer as I do. But I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed, and I am convinced that he is able to guard until that day what has been entrusted to me.

At our March 1985 Bible conference, Dr Calloway spoke on Samuel going to Jesse to anoint David. Dr Calloway's message was that "God re-parents us." He will put someone in front of you who speaks one sentence that will cause you to come to God, making you change, to repent, to turn from sin.

Spiritual direction (or spiritual mentoring) is a centuries-old practice to help shape our lives and our service in Christlike patterns [modeled on Jesus, whose way of developing leaders was not classroom teaching, but life upon life like a master craftsman tutoring a young apprentice: On the road to Emmaus in Luke 24:27 KJV And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself. My ETHOS is my transformed life as it is being revealed by the Word. *Ethos* is a Greek word meaning 'character' and is used to describe the guiding beliefs or ideals that characterize a community, nation, or ideology. The Greeks also used this word to refer to the power of music in influencing emotions, behaviors, and even morals. In modern usage, ETHOS denotes the disposition, character, or fundamental values peculiar to a specific person, group of people, corporation, culture, or movement. 1 John 1:9 states, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

How to Write Your Story: Finding Your Headline: Who is Jesus to you? What scripture compels you to Christ? When did you come to "know" Christ? Through Scriptures, share Where you have experienced God changing you and helping you overcome lies you have believed about Him; Share Why you believe; Share How you are drawn by the Holy Spirit to Christ? What's the central theme or 'headline' of your story? Choose the headline below that best illustrates your experience and delete the others. If none of these resonate, feel free to create your own:

Your personal story, your "testimony," is an effective connection point to others: It is your history. Note, it is HIS-story, the Story of Jesus in you. Writing your story down and being ready to stand up and tell it when GOD puts someone in front of you, believe me, that's a godwink moment: Acts 17:30-31 KJV And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: [31] Because He hath appointed a day, in the which He will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom He hath ordained; whereof He hath given assurance unto all men, in that He hath raised Him from the dead.

Just as in a courtroom one tells "what I saw" or "what I heard" or "here is what happened," so it is with your story of coming to faith in Christ. You must want people to know what matters in your life, what is the most important thing that has ever happened in your life. You were there! You know what happened and what Jesus has done in your life. People relate to real life examples. You can tell others in such a way that they too can come to faith in Christ. Here is a simple way to express your story. Write the details in a conversational way with each point. You could begin by saying "Could I tell you about my spiritual journey and what has really made a difference?" or by simply asking, "May I tell you my story?"

1. Tell about—My life before I came to faith in Jesus. What was your life like? What concerns did you have? What fears did you have? What problems did you face? What did you try to do to "fix" yourself or your situation before you came to Jesus? No need to go into great detail about your sin. Share in a way that does not glorify or brag about the things that were wrong in your life. For some who came to Christ early in life, there are not a lot of "big" sins, but there is always a spiritual need in every life.

2. Tell about—How I came to place faith in Jesus personally. When did you first hear about Jesus Christ? What about Jesus got your attention? When did you begin to be convicted about your sins? What other spiritual truths did you begin to think about? The love of God? The needs of your own life? Fear of the future? What did you think of the story of Jesus, His life, His death for your sins, His resurrection from the grave? What Scriptures touched you? Where were you and when did you call on the Lord to forgive you and save you, giving Him your life, placing faith in Him as Lord and Savior?

3. Tell about—How Jesus has changed my life since I placed faith in Him. Did salvation change your desired career choice? What changes did I notice at first? What changes have I seen over the months or years since placing faith in Jesus? Have I had a Barnabas encourager to help me? How has Jesus impacted my life? How is life different in Point 3 than it was in Point 1? What is going on in my life now because of Christ? How is He real day by day? What did you experience in the Holy Spirit leading this week?

- ___ Brought my belief system back into line with what is true through renewing my mind using 'stronghold-busting'
- ___ Realized all the lies I had been believing and took steps to change my beliefs
- ___ Realized that I can be a success in God's eyes but a complete failure in the eyes of the world (or vice versa)
- ___ Was completely released from all the negative effects of the past.
