Matthew 2:10 HCSB

When they saw the star, they were overjoyed beyond **measure**.

Matthew 7:2 AMP

For just as you [hypocritically] judge others [when you are sinful and unrepentant], so will you be judged; and in accordance with your standard of **measure** [used to pass out judgment], judgment will be **measured** to you.

Matthew 13:33 AMP

He told them another parable, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and worked into three **measures** of flour until all of it was leavened."

Matthew 23:32 AMP

Fill up, then, the [allotted] **measure** of the guilt of your fathers' sins.

Mark 4:24 AMP

Then He said to them, "Pay attention to what you hear. By your own standard of **measurement** [that is, to the extent that you study spiritual truth and apply godly wisdom] it will be **measured** to you [and you will be given even greater ability to respond]—and more will be given to you besides.

Mark 6:51 KJV

And he went up unto them into the ship; and the wind ceased: and they were sore amazed in themselves beyond **measure**, and wondered.

Mark 7:37 KJV

And were beyond **measure** astonished, saying, He hath done all things well: he maketh both the deaf to hear, and the dumb to speak.

Mark 10:26 KJV

And they were astonished out of **measure**, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved?

Luke 6:38 AMP

Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good **measure**—pressed down, shaken together, and running over [with no space left for more]. For with the standard of **measurement** you use [when you do good to others], it will be **measured** to you in return."

Luke 9:48 TLB

and said to them, "Anyone who takes care of a little child like this is caring for me! And whoever cares for me is caring for God who sent me. Your care for others is the **measure** of your greatness."

Luke 13:21 AMP

It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three peck **measures** of flour until it was all leavened."

Luke 16:6 AMP

He said, 'A hundred **measures** of [olive] oil.' And he said to him, 'Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.'

Luke 16:7 AMP

Then he said to another, 'And how much do you owe?' He said, 'A hundred **measures** of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, and write eighty.'

John 2:6 LSB

Now there were six stone water jars set there for the Jewish custom of purification, containing two or three **measures** each.

John 3:33 TLB

Those who believe him discover that God is a fountain of truth. For this one sent by God speaks God's words, for God's Spirit is upon him without **measure** or limit.

John 3:34 AMP

For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God [proclaiming the Father's own message]; for God gives the [gift of the] Spirit without **measure** [generously and boundlessly]!

And here is how to **measure** it-the greatest love is shown when a person lays down his life for his friends;

Romans 7:13 HCSB

Therefore, did what is good cause my death? Absolutely not! On the contrary, sin, in order to be recognized as sin, was producing death in me through what is good, so that through the commandment, sin might become sinful beyond **measure**.

Romans 12:3 BSB

For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more

highly than you ought, but think of yourself with sober judgment, according to the **measure** of faith God has given you.

2 Corinthians 1:8 KJV

For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of **measure**, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:

2 Corinthians 4:17 AMP

For our momentary, light distress [this passing trouble] is producing for us an eternal weight of glory [a fullness] beyond all **measure** [surpassing all comparisons, a transcendent splendor and an endless blessedness]!

2 Corinthians 9:14 AMP

and they also long for you while they pray on your behalf, because of the surpassing **measure** of God's grace [His undeserved favor, mercy, and blessing which is revealed] in you.

2 Corinthians 10:12 AMP

We do not have the audacity to put ourselves in the same class or compare ourselves with some who [supply testimonials to] commend themselves. When they **measure** themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they lack wisdom and behave like fools.

2 Corinthians 10:13 AMP

We, on the other hand, will not boast beyond our proper limit, but [will keep] within the limits of our commission (territory, authority) which God has granted to us as a **measure**, which reaches and includes even you.

2 Corinthians 10:14 KJV

For we stretch not ourselves beyond our **measure**, as though we reached not unto you: for we are come as far as to you also in preaching the gospel of Christ:

2 Corinthians 10:15 HCSB

We are not bragging beyond **measure** about other people's labors. But we have the hope that as your faith increases, our area of ministry will be greatly enlarged,

2 Corinthians 11:9 WEB

When I was present with you and was in need, I wasn't a burden on anyone, for the brothers, when they came from Macedonia, supplied the **measure** of my need. In everything I kept myself from being burdensome to you, and I will continue to do so.

2 Corinthians 11:23 KJV

Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above **measure**, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

2 Corinthians 12:7 KJV

And lest I should be exalted above **measure** through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above **measure**.

Galatians 1:13 KJV

For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond **measure** I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

Ephesians 4:7 AMP

Yet grace [God's undeserved favor] was given to each one of us [not indiscriminately, but in different ways] in proportion to the **measure** of Christ's [rich and abundant] gift.

Ephesians 4:13 AMP

until we all reach oneness in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God, [growing spiritually] to become a mature believer, reaching to the **measure** of the fullness of Christ [manifesting His spiritual completeness and exercising our spiritual gifts in unity].

Ephesians 4:16 KJV

From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the **measure** of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

1 Thessalonians 2:16 AMP

forbidding us from speaking to the Gentiles (non-Jews) so that they may be saved. So, as always, they fill up [to the brim] the **measure** of their sins [allotted to them by God]. But [God's] wrath has come upon them at last [completely and forever].

2 Timothy 2:16 HCSB

But avoid irreverent, empty speech, for this will produce an even greater **measure** of godlessness.

1 John 4:13 CEB

This is how we know we remain in him and he remains in us, because he has given us a **measure** of his Spirit.

Revelation 6:6 KJV

And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A **measure** of wheat for a penny, and three **measures** of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

Revelation 11:1 AMP

Then there was given to me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Rise and **measure** the temple of God and the altar [of incense], and [count] those who worship in it.

Revelation 11:2 AMP

But leave out the court [of the Gentiles] which is outside the temple and do not **measure** it, because it has been given to the Gentiles (the nations); and they will trample the holy city for forty-two months (three and one-half years).

Revelation 18:7 BSB

As much as she has glorified herself and lived in luxury, give her the same **measure** of torment and grief. In her heart she says, 'I sit as queen; I am not a widow and will never see grief.'

Revelation 21:15 AMP

The one who was speaking with me had a gold measuring rod to **measure** the city, and its gates and its wall.

Revelation 21:16 AMP

The city is laid out as a square, its length being the same as its width; and he **measured** the city with his rod—twelve thousand stadia (about 1,400 miles); its length and width and height are equal.

Revelation 21:17 AMP

He **measured** its wall also—a hundred forty-four cubits (about 200 feet), according to man's **measurements**, which are [also] angelic [**measurements**].
